As development and urban sprawl consume more land wildlife habitat is not necessarily lost. Wildlife biologists and researchers are finding higher carrying capacities within urban sprawl areas compared to rural and wilderness areas. Wildlife do not realize they are trespassing when they damage your property or invade your home. When wildlife does damage or becomes a nuisance, it may become necessary to trap and relocate them to a more rural area or wildlife management area.

Due to an increasing number of rabies within East Tennessee, current state regulations prohibit the relocation of skunk, raccoon and coyote. Most all other wildlife can be relocated. McMillan Wildlife Control is licensed by Tennessee Wildlife Resource Agency (TWRRA) and is fully insured.

Rolling Meadows is located in the back hills of the Blue Ridge Mountains in Gainesville, GA approximately 60 miles NE of Atlanta, GA. We're only 4 miles off I-76 and easy to find.

We purchased our first goats in the early 90's, which were six of various breeds and colors. Over the years we developed some Carolina and mixed breeds with a substantial blood stock and used this as a learning experience. Later we sold those and purchased 10 different breeds using all logistic tools and a lot of talent for our breeding continuously adding other areas and bloodlines.

Over reading an article, we discovered there was a goat called 'Buck' and all the information was true of the animal of breed I wanted to try it. I joined the American Alpaca Goat Association and asked for information on the breed. These months later, after seeing various breeders from the US, I decided to try the breed. I finally found someone who would let me look at his goats, I was able to purchase 11 does and one buck. I would have been happy to have purchased more but at that time, those were all he would sell.

As time went on, we discovered the characteristics of the 'New Forest Breed' we had discovered were all out of this breed. All breeds were developed, some had been developed for many years and some were still in the process of being developed.
